Please pay attention to the stated deadlines. After the deadlines have passed, entries will only be accepted if there is sufficient space available on the shooting line, **this includes the preliminary date.**

Final entries processed after the deadline will have a penalty fee of R500 per archer to be paid to the OC prior to / at the moment of arriving at the event.

CLOSED EVENT = World Archery awards are available to all participants. **1440 Round titles and trophies will only be awarded to South African members.**

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

There are 2 components to this tournament:

1440 Round (36 arrows at the age / category appropriate distances) and a 720 Round (72 arrows at the age / category appropriate distances).

Archers can enter for either the 1440 Round / 720 Round or both of the Rounds

Entry fee will be dependent on whether you are competing in 1 or 2 Rounds.
